We thank Terri and Bill for their dedication and support to our school community!

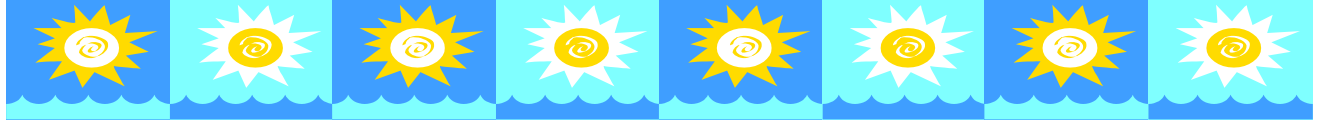
News

Dear St. Hilary's Families,

Back by request, you can now display your child's masterpieces proudly! We'd like to announce that you will have the opportunity to have a piece/pieces of your child's artwork matted and framed. The details are listed below and the money raised for this project will be used toward the Fine Arts Program. Your artwork will look very professional in the mats and frames and make wonderful additions to your homes, or are wonderful gifts for grandparents, holidays, etc.!

*All frames will be wooden and an appropriately colored mat board will be chosen to enhance your child's artwork. You may choose from a black, light wood, or dark wood color frame.

I will be doing all the matting and framing myself and so you will receive your finished pieces during the *fall of 2010*.

Prices:

If you have ever matted and framed an artwork before, you can see that these prices are extremely reasonable in comparison to a framing or craft store! Artwork may vary in size depending on the project, but below are general guidelines for the mats and frames:

Artwork that is approximately 9 X 12 or smaller will cost \$35.00 for the mat and the frame (for ordering purposes, this is considered SMALL)

Artwork that is approximately 12 X 18 will cost \$45.00 for the mat and the frame (for ordering purposes, this is considered LARGE)

Print out, complete the order form and return to **MRS. CARLO** by **June 4, 2010**. Please make your check out to St. Hilary of Poitiers School. **I WILL NOT accept orders after this date, so please send in by the deadline. I will also not order a frame unless I have payment in hand.** Thank you!
